Southwark Spine (South) cycling improvements

The London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (Disabled persons) (No. *) Order 201* The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 201*

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be to:-
- (a) (i) relocate an existing 'unlimited stay' disabled persons' parking place in MAXTED ROAD to the south-east side of OGLANDER ROAD (the side of No. 22 Maxted Road), and (ii) to remove an existing 'unlimited stay' disabled persons' parking place in OGLANDER ROAD (o/s No. 4 Oglander Road);
- (b) add or amend 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines 'DYLs') in the following locations to maximise the effects of the cycling improvements and traffic calming: ADYS ROAD both sides at its junctions with Oglander Road, with Nutbrook Road and Amott Road; CRYSTAL PALACE ROAD (i) both sides across its junctions with Whateley Road/Underhill Road, Silvester Road and Goodrich Road, and (ii) west side, across its junctions with Pellatt Road, Rodwell Road, Heber Road and Jennings Road;

GOODRICH ROAD, HEBER ROAD, JENNINGS ROAD, PELLATT ROAD, RODWELL ROAD and SILVESTER ROAD both sides add DYLs at their junctions with Crystal Palace Road;

MAXTED ROAD (i) north-east side, extending DYLs across its junctions with McDermott and Wingfield Street and (ii) south-west side, extending DYLs across its junction with Oglander Road; and OGLANDER ROAD both sides between its junctions with Maxted Road and with Adys Road.

- 3. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE that it has approved under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the provision of a raised 'zebra' pedestrian crossing in CRYSTAL PALACE ROAD the centre of which would be located at the common boundary of Nos. 194 and 196, zig-zag markings on which vehicles would be prohibited from stopping at all times would be (i) the west side, 4 metres north of this crossing and 6 metres south of this crossing and (ii) the east side, 6 metres north of this crossing and 4 metres south of this crossing.
- 4. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980² and in accordance with the provisions of the Highways (Road humps) Regulations 1999³ and the Highways (Traffic calming) Regulations 1999⁴, propose to: (a) construct speed tables of flat-top construction having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the entire width of the carriageway, at the following locations:-

ADYS ROAD and OGLANDER ROAD junction, from a point in Oglander Road 6 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Adys Road extending south-westward for a distance of 23 metres, and south-eastward into ADYS ROAD for a distance of 10 metres;

CRYSTAL PALACE ROAD at its junction with Whateley Road/Underhill Road: from a point in Crystal Palace Road 6 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Underhill Road (as measured on the eastern side) extending south-westward for a distance of 20 metres (includes the site of the above-mentioned zebra crossing), (ii) from its western kerb-line into WHATELEY ROAD westward for a distance of 8 metres, and (iii) from its eastern kerb-line into UNDERHILL ROAD eastward for a distance of 5 metres;

CRYSTAL PALACE ROAD at its junction with Goodrich Road: from a point in Crystal Palace Road 6 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line build-out of Goodrich Road (as measured on the eastern side) extending south-westward for a distance of 20 metres, and in GOODRICH ROAD from a point 6 metres south-east of the south-western kerb-line of Crystal Palace Road north-westward for a distance of 19 metres; and

(b) place new road humps of sinusoidal cross-section construction, approx. 3.7 metres in length, having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the greater width of the carriageway, in:
(i) CRYSTAL PALACE ROAD centred at the common boundary of Nos. 1 and 3, centred at the common boundary of Nos. 27 and 29, centred at a point 1 metre north-east of the common boundary of Nos. 116 and 118, and centred at a point 12 metres south-west of the south-western

wall of No. 144; and (ii) OGLANDER ROAD centred at a point 1.5 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos. 10 and 12.

Southwark Spine (South) cycling improvements

The London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (Disabled persons) (No. *) Order 201* The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 201*

This proposal aims to provide a series of traffic calming measures (raised tables, crossing points, sinusoidal speed humps, road narrowing, signing and road marking) and new cycle lanes to create a safe environment for cyclists to navigate a safe route from north (Peckham area) to south (East Dulwich area) within the London Borough of Southwark. This will compliment existing Quietway¹ routes and will provide a link to the new north to south Cycle Superhighway on Blackfriars Road.

This part of the 'Southwark Spine' will focus on the southern part of this scheme within the Goose Green and Dulwich Hill wards – from Maxted Road to Goodrich Road in the London Borough of Southwark.

The proposals for the southern section of 'Southwark Spine' are summarised below:

- Implement new and amend existing waiting restrictions throughout the area; in Adys Road, Crystal Palace Road, Goodrich Road, Heber Road, Jennings Road, Maxted Road, Oglander Road, Pellatt Road, Rodwell Road and Silvester Road.

- Relocate an existing 'unlimited stay' disabled persons' parking place in Maxted Road to the south-east side of Oglander Road (the side of No. 22 Maxted Road), and remove an existing 'unlimited stay' disabled persons' parking place o/s No. 4 Oglander Road.

- Improve, by removals or replacing, road humps along the 'Southwark Spine' roads.

- Widen footways and improve surfacing throughout the area.

 New raised speed tables at the following locations: Adys Road and Oglander Road junction Crystal Palace Road at its junction with Whateley Road/Underhill Road Crystal Palace Road and Goodrich Road junction


- New raised zebra pedestrian crossing in Crystal Palace Road north of its junction with Whateley Road/Underhill Road.



Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2013 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of a Schedule to this Order is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2013 (other than Articles 3.1 and 14.1) shall apply to each area described in a Schedule to this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place shall include a reference to each area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2013 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs etc.

- 5.1 The council shall:-
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order;
