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Queen Elizabeth Street area improvements

The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ'G') (No. *) Order 201* The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 201*

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be, within CPZ 'G', in:-
- (a) BOSS STREET south-east side, (i) add 12 metres permit holders' parking, and (ii) extend by 2 metres and reposition an existing 'pay and display' parking place;
- (b) QUEEN ELIZABETH STREET (i) north-east side to reduce in length by 3.5 metres and relocate an existing permit holders' parking place to new location outside Candishe House, and (ii) southwest side, extend by 2 metres and reposition an existing permit holders' parking place opposite Candishe House; and
- (c) to amend existing waiting restrictions to accommodate the above-mentioned changes to parking in BOSS STREET and QUEEN ELIZABETH STREET.
- 3. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980² and in accordance with the provisions of the Highways (Traffic calming) Regulations 1999³, propose to construct a speed table of flat-top construction having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the entire width of the carriageway, at the junction of BOSS STREET and QUEEN ELIZABETH STREET. Extending from a point, in Queen Elizabeth Street, 12 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Boss Street, south-eastward for a distance of 24 metres, and extending south-westward into Boss Street for a distance of 7 metres.

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Statement of reasons

Queen Elizabeth Street area improvements

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The proposals relate to the redevelopment of Tower Bridge Magistrates Court and Police Station which was given planning permission (15/AP/3303) on 8th March 2016 and allows for the extension, alteration and a new build floorspace with associated vehicle and cycle parking.

These implementations will make amendments to the part of Boss Street and Queen Elizabeth Street within the North Bermondsey ward, in the London Borough of Southwark.

Highway works include:

- the provision of a new raised table at the junction of Boss Street and Queen Elizabeth Street - adding, relocating and/or amending existing parking spaces within controlled parking zone (CPZ) 'G'


- BOSS STREET south-east side, (i) add 12 metres permit holders' parking, and (ii) extend by 2 metres and reposition an existing 'pay and display' parking place;
- (b) QUEEN ELIZABETH STREET (i) north-east side to reduce in length by 3.5 metres and relocate an existing permit holders' parking place to new location outside Candishe House, and (ii) south-west side, extend by 2 metres and reposition an existing permit holders' parking place opposite Candishe House.

- to amend existing waiting restrictions to accommodate the above-mentioned changes to parking in Boss Street and Queen Elizabeth Street.

Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Parking Places) (CPZ 'G') (No. xx) Order 201* and shall come into force on xx xxxxx 201*.

Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

"the Order of 2011" means The London Borough of Southwark (Parking Places) (CPZ 'G') (No. 1) Order 2011^b.

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2011 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Revocation

3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the designation by the Order of 2011 of the parking places numbered 148 and 151 in Schedule 1 therein and the parking place numbered 1 in Schedule 3, are hereby revoked.

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2011 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in columns (2) of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, and having a width throughout of 2 metres, is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2011 (other than Articles 3 and 15) shall apply to each area designated as a parking place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a designated parking place or to a parking place shall include a reference to the area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2011 included a reference to Schedule 1 to this Order, and as if any reference to Schedule 3 to the Order of 2011 included a reference to Schedule 2 to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs etc.

- 5.1 The council shall:-
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order;
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order traffic signs indicating that such a parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.4 of the Order of 2011; and
 - (c) carry out such other works as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.
