To provide disabled persons parking places on-street to assist disabled residents in Adys Road, Badsworth Road, Bellenden Road, Bird in Bush Road, Calypso Crescent, Camberwell Grove, Camilla Road, Chesterfield Grove, Crebor Street, East Dulwich Grove, Green Dale, John Ruskin Street, Kirkwood Road, Landells Road, Linden Grove, Loder Street, Lordship Lane, Lynton Road, Marsden Road, Moody Road, Pennethorne Road, Playfield Crescent, Raul Road, St George's Way and Upland Road; amending the designation of existing parking restrictions where necessary. The permit holders' parking within CPZ 'L' will be amended in the new Order to reflect more closely what is in Camberwell Grove.

The above-mentioned parking places will all be 6.6 metres in length, apart from where otherwise stated, and would operate at any time and without time limit by vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons 'blue badge'.

There will also be the removal of 'unlimited stay' disabled persons parking places that are no longer needed in Belvoir Road, Caulfield Road, Denman Road, Fellbrigg Road, Hansler Road, Harmsworth Street, Rodwell Road, Soames Street, Tarbert Road and West Square. These removals will necessitate the following:

- in Denman Road, within CPZ 'PR' adding 6 metres of permit holders' parking;
- in Harmsworth Street add 'at any time' waiting restrictions outside No. 11;
- in West Square, within CPZ 'C2', two existing permit holders' parking places will be joined and extended adding 6.5 metres of permit holders' parking.

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

"the Order of 2019" means The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'R') (No. 1) Order 2019^b.

- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2019 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Revocation

3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the designation by the Order of 2019 of the parking place numbered 18 in Schedule 1 and the parking place numbered 42 in Schedule 3 therein are hereby revoked.

Designation of parking place and application of the Order of 2019 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column (2) of a Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2019 (other than Articles 3, 16 and 17) shall apply to the areas described in each Schedule to this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a designated parking place or to a parking place shall include a reference to the area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if:-
 - (i) any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2019 included a reference to Schedule 1 to this Order; and
 - (ii) any reference to Schedule 3 to the Order of 2019 included a reference to Schedule 2 to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs, etc.

- 5.1 The council shall:-
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Order;
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Order traffic signs indicating that such a parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Article 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3, as the case may be, of the Order of 2019;
 - (c) carry out such other works as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.
