THE LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK (DICKENS SQUARE PARK) STOPPING UP ORDER 2020

Made this Hith day of February 2020

The London Borough of Southwark ("the Council") makes this Order in exercise of its powers under Section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) ("the Act") and all other enabling powers.

- 1. The Council authorises the stopping up of the area of highway described in the Schedule to this Order and shown hatched black on the drawing attached hereto and labelled Dickens Square Park.
- 2. This Order is made to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted by the Council on 08 October 2019 under local planning authority reference number No. 10/AP/1650 for:-

'Landscape works and other operations to include re-location of existing adventure play facility, provision of a playground and play facility, alterations to boundary walls, stopping up of road, footpaths and hard surfaces, hard landscape detailing of entrances, tree removals, and tree and shrub planting.'

- 3. Where immediately before the date of this Order there is any apparatus of statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across any length of highway authorised to be stopped up pursuant to this Order then those undertakers shall have the same rights as respects that apparatus after that area of highway has been stopped up as they had immediately beforehand.
- 4. This Order shall come into force on the date on which notice that it has been made is first published in accordance with Section 252 (10) of the Act, and may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Dickens Square Park) Stopping Up Order 2019.


