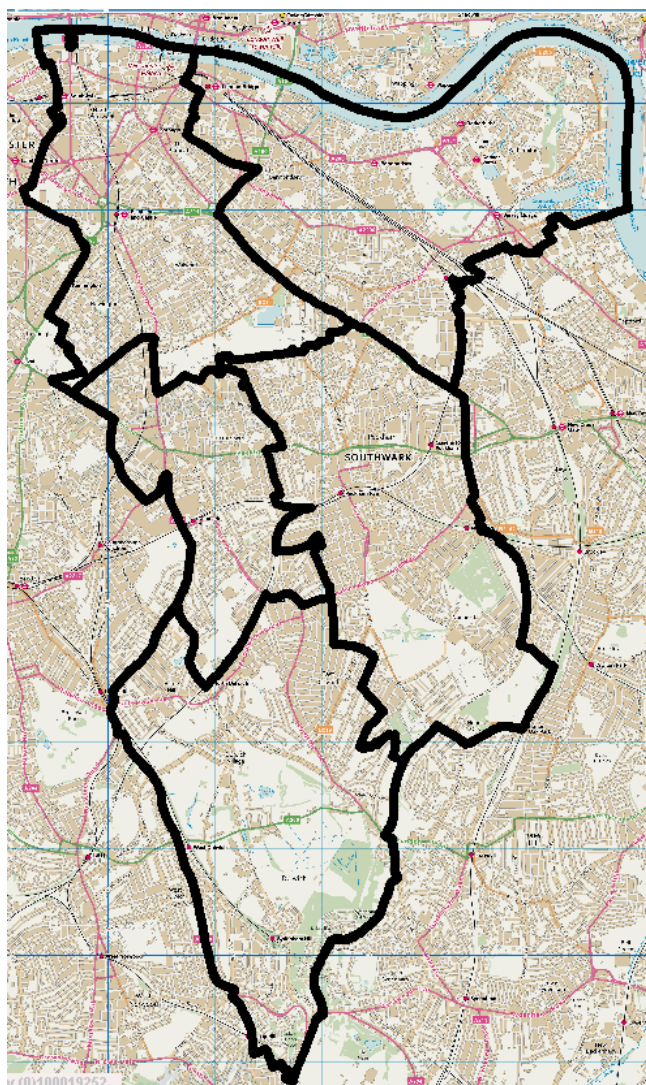


SOUTHWARK COUNCIL COMMUNITY COUNCIL PROFILES OVERVIEW



There were **288,283** residents estimated to be living in the London Borough of Southwark when the latest Census was conducted on 27th March 2011.

The Council is divided into 21 wards, which are grouped together to form five Community Councils: Bermondsey and Rotherhithe, Borough, Bankside and Walworth, Camberwell, Dulwich, and Peckham and Nunhead.

The Community Councils form part of the council's decision making process. They consist of area-based public meetings held five times a year where local people can meet together with their ward councillors to discuss local matters and issues of concern. These elected councillors make decisions on areas such as traffic management, community safety and environmental improvements. The Community Councils also allocate money through the Community Council Fund, the Cleaner Greener Safer Capital & Revenue Scheme, and the Highways Capital Investment programme.

In order to support the Community Councils to fulfil their role, profiles have been developed outlining the key characteristics of each Community Council area..

This document provides a summary table for the key characteristics for each of the Community Councils along with overall proportions for Southwark and England. In addition to this, there are five separate documents for each of the Community Council areas containing a brief analysis of characteristics for each locality.

The final page of this document contains a table which defines each of the characteristics provided in the profiles.

Characteristic	Definition
Demography	
Gender	The proportion of Census 2011 respondents identifying as male or female.
Age	The proportion of Census 2011 respondents in each age band.
Ethnic Group	The proportion of Census 2011 respondents in each ethnic group.
Religion	The proportion of Census 2011 respondents identifying as belonging to each religion. Religions with less than 1% of respondents have been excluded.
English Proficiency	The proportion of Census 2011 respondents by their ability to speak English.
Economy	
Economic Activity	The proportion of Census 2011 respondents that are either retired, economically inactive students, looking after home or family, long-term sick or disabled or otherwise economically inactive.
Benefits	The proportion of the working-age (16-64) population that are claiming one or more DWP benefits.
Housing	
Housing Type	The proportion of Census 2011 households by accommodation type.
Household Tenure	The proportion of Census 2011 households by tenure type.
Health & Disability	
Health	The proportion of Census 2011 respondents identifying as either being in bad or very bad health.
Childhood Obesity	The proportion of children measured by the National Child Measurement Programme 2009/10 to 2011/12 that are obese by age group.
Disability	The proportion of Census 2011 respondents whose day to day activities are limited either a little or a lot.
