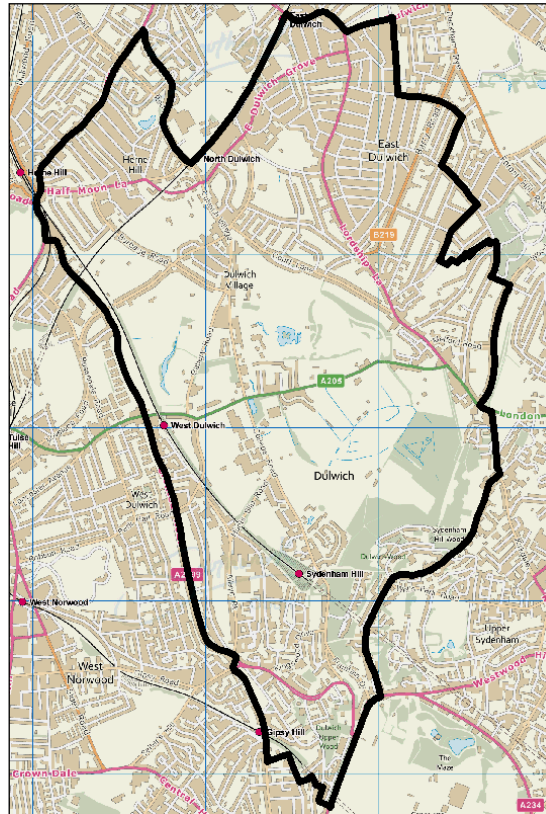


DULWICH COMMUNITY COUNCIL PROFILE



There were **36,535** residents estimated to be living in the Dulwich Community Council area when the latest Census was conducted on 27th March 2011. This profile highlights some of the key information for the area.

- Dulwich has a higher proportion of residents aged under 15 (21%) than both the Borough and national averages of 19%. The area has the highest proportion of residents aged 65+ in the Borough (10%), however this is still below the national average of 16%.
- The majority of residents in Dulwich are White (72%) and this is the highest in the Borough, although still below the national average of 85%. The proportion of Black/African/Caribbean/Black British residents is the lowest in the Borough (14%) but higher than the national average of 3%.
- Dulwich has the lowest proportion of residents in the Borough that identify as Christian (49%) and the highest proportion that identify as having no religion (34%). Dulwich also has a higher than average proportion of residents identifying as Hindu (2%).
- The proportion of residents in Dulwich that are economically inactive (23%) is the lowest in the Borough and below the national average of 30%.
- Half of Dulwich residents live in a whole house or bungalow, which is more than twice the Borough average of 24% although lower than the national average of 77%.
- The proportion of households in Dulwich that are social rented (21%) is less than half the Borough average of 44%, however this is still higher than the national average of 18%.
- Dulwich has lower proportions of childhood obesity than both the Borough and national averages.
- The proportion of residents whose day to day activities are limited (12%) is lower than both the Borough average of 14% and the national average of 18%.
