

## MISCELLANEOUS PUBLIC NOTICE

## LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK

## CIVIC AMENITIES ACT, 1967

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Southwark, having determined that the parts of the Borough more particularly described in the Schedule hereto are areas of special architectural or historic interest, the character or appearance of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance, on the 24th July 1968 designated them as Conservation Areas pursuant to the provisions of section 1 of the Civic Amenities Act, 1967.

Maps showing the extent of the Areas are deposited at the Department of Architecture and Planning, 30-32 Peckham Road, London S.E.5, and may be inspected from Mondays to Fridays between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.
