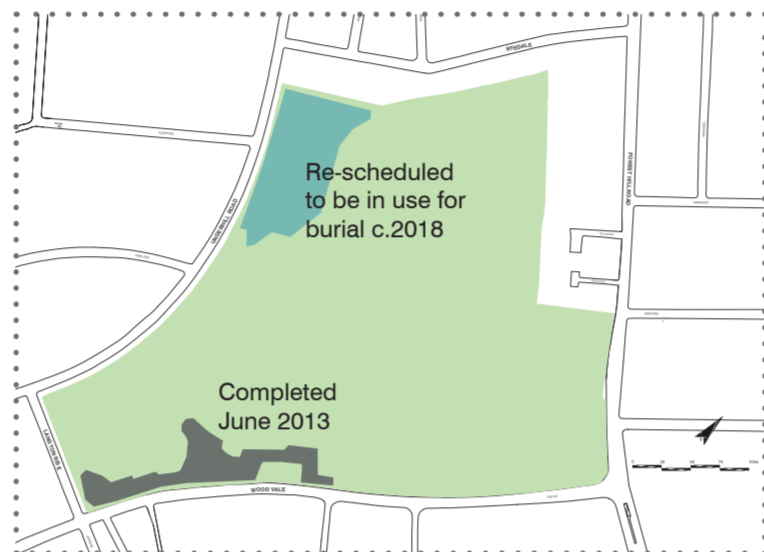


CAMBERWELL OLD CEMETERY:

KEY FACTS



The Proposal:

- seeks to bring a currently fenced 'out of bounds' area of the cemetery back into public use as a burial area, providing approximately 700 burial plots;
- retains many significant mature trees and integrates them into the new layout;
- involves the clearance of existing self seeded shrub vegetation, and the removal of 19 significant trees;
- includes clearing poor quality soils and unsuitable materials which have resulted from past unauthorised waste disposal;
- requires land modelling and additional soils to prepare the site for burial, and make it safe for public access;
- retains existing vegetation and significant trees to the Underhill Road and Ryedale boundaries;
- includes biodiversity enhancements through native tree and shrub planting;
- includes a new cemetery pathway and the refurbishment of an existing pathway;
- requires a temporary site access point for construction traffic from Langton Rise.
