### Proposal to build new homes at Alscot Road– Soil Survey

I'm writing to let you know that planned soil survey investigations will be carried out on the residential car park at Alscot Road on **Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> February 2021 to Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2021 between 8:00 am and 6:00 pm.**

In order to complete the survey there will be suspensions to some parking bays at Alscot Road. The soil survey works are estimated to take between one and six days. Please refer to the site map below:



The parking bays marked with the yellow cross will be suspended on the above dates. The suspended parking bay numbers will be 1,12,13,14,21,33.

We aim to get these works completed as quickly as possible to minimise any inconvenience.

The purpose of the soil survey is to ensure we obtain information to assist us with the design development of the new buildings.

The works will involve drilling boreholes for the purpose of collecting environmental soil samples and undertaking ground gas and groundwater monitoring.

Unfortunately the works will create some noise whilst the holes are being drilled. When each borehole is completed it will be carefully backfilled. Every effort will be made to reinstate the ground to a suitable standard once works have ceased.

We apologise in advance that these works will likely cause some disturbances and inconvenience to anyone using the specified parking bays mentioned at the top of this letter.

**PLEASE NOTE:**

Cars will be removed if there are parked within the specified bays mentioned at the top of this letter on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> February 2021 to Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2021 between 8:00 am and 6:00 pm. If you suspect that your vehicle has been removed;
