Disabled persons parking places

The London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (Disabled persons) (No.53) Order 2017 The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'C2') (No. 24) Order 2017 The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'K') (No. 2) Order 2017 The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No.36) Order 2017 The London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (No. 14) Order 2017

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be:
 - to provide new disabled persons parking places, 6 metres in length, at the following locations: (a) BELVOIR ROAD, on the north east side outside No.20 Belvoir Road; BROOK DRIVE, on the north east side, outside No.132 Brook Drive; CHADWICK ROAD, on the south side outside No.145 Chadwick Road; COPLESTON ROAD, on the east side outside No.111 Copleston Road; CRAWTHEW GROVE, on the north side *outside* No.6 Crawthew Grove; CREDON ROAD, on the west side outside No. 42 Credon Road; CRYSTAL PALACE ROAD, on the west side outside No.192 Crystal Palace Road: EAST DULWICH GROVE, the south east side, *outside* Nos.93 East Dulwich Grove; FARQUHAR ROAD, the south-west side *outside* Glenhurst Court, Farguhar Road; FELLBRIGG ROAD, the east side outside No.77 Fellbrigg Road; HARLESCOTT ROAD, the south-east side outside No.47 Harlescott Road; LATONA ROAD, the south side outside No.56 Latona Road; MCDOWALL ROAD, the south-east side outside No.4 McDowall Road; MELBOURNE GROVE, the south-west side outside No.148 Melbourne Grove; NEEDLEMAN STREET, the west side outside Vancouver House, Needleman Street; NUNHEAD GROVE, the south-west side to the side of No.66 Nunhead Lane; PELHAM CLOSE, the south-west side to the side of No.6 Pelham Close; RYE HILL PARK, the south-east side outside No.73 Rye Hill Park; WOODWARDE ROAD, the south-west side outside No.155 Woodwarde Road: WOODWARDE ROAD, the north-east side outside Nos. 32 and 34 Woodwarde Road; These parking places would operate at any time, and may be used without time limit by vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons 'blue badge'.
 - (b) to split an existing permit holders' parking place in BROOK DRIVE so as to accommodate the provision of the new disabled persons parking place referred to above;
 - (c) to split an existing permit holders' parking place in MCDOWALL ROAD so as to accommodate the provision of the new disabled persons parking place referred to above;
 - (d) to remove a length of 'at any time' waiting restrictions in NEEDLEMAN STREET so as to accommodate the provision of the new disabled persons parking place referred to above;
 - (e) to remove a length of 'at any time' waiting restrictions in PELHAM CLOSE so as to accommodate the provision of the new disabled persons parking place referred to above and a free parking space;
 - (f) to split an existing free parking place in EAST DULWICH GROVE so as to accommodate the provision of the new disabled persons parking place referred to above
 - (g) to remove disabled persons parking places that are no longer needed in Denman Road, Glengarry Road, Lanbury Road, Lyndhurst Grove, Webber Row and Woodwarde Road.
 - (h) to remove a length of free parking space in LATONA ROAD so as to accommodate the provision of the new disabled persons parking place referred to above
