# Pedal cycle 'Quietway' route Q7: Green Dale to Farquhar Road

The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed routes) (Pedal cycle quietways) (No. \*) Traffic Order 201\*

The London Borough of Southwark Cycle Tracks Order (Pedal cycle quietways) (No. \*) 201\* The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (Car club) (No. \*) Order 201\* The London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (No. \*) Order 201\* The London Borough of Southwark (Loading bays) (No. \*) Order 201\* The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. \*) Order 201\*

- Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, as amended, or in the case of the cycle tracks order, under section 3 of the Cycle Tracks Act 1984<sup>2</sup>, following the procedure set out in the Cycle Tracks Regulations 1984<sup>3</sup>.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be:-
  - to introduce a south-westbound segregated cycle lane in CALTON AVENUE between its junctions with Court Lane and Dulwich Village, aligned with the south-eastern kerb;
  - (b) to introduce a north-eastbound segregated cycle lane in TURNEY ROAD between a point 28 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Dulwich Village and its junction with Dulwich Village, aligned with the north-western kerb;
  - (c) to introduce a north-eastbound cycle lane in DULWICH WOOD AVENUE throughout the length of the carriageway located to the south of the triangular island site opposite Nos. 1-12 'The Garvens' and Nos. 53-55 Dulwich Wood Avenue, aligned with the north-western kerb;
  - (d) to introduce one-way south-westbound traffic working for all vehicles except pedal cycles in DULWICH WOOD AVENUE throughout the length of the carriageway located to the south of the triangular island site opposite Nos. 1-12 'The Garvens' and Nos. 53-55 Dulwich Wood Avenue;
  - to introduce a southbound semi-segregated cycle lane in FARQUHAR ROAD between its junction with Dulwich Wood Avenue and a point opposite its southernmost junction with Jasper Road, aligned with the western and southwestern kerb;
  - (f) to introduce new or extend existing lengths of 'at any time' waiting restrictions in:-

BURBAGE ROAD, on both sides at its junction with Turney Road;

CALTON AVENUE, (i) on both sides at its junction with Woodwarde Road, (ii) on the north-west side at its junction with Gilkes Crescent; (iii) on both sides between its junctions with Gilkes Crescent and Dulwich Village;

COLBY ROAD, on both sides at its junction with Dulwich Wood Avenue;

COURT LANE, (i) on both sides at its junction with Calton Avenue, and (ii) on the north-east side at its junction with Dekker Road;

DEKKER ROAD, on both sides at its junction with Court Lane;

DULWICH VILLAGE, on both sides at its junctions with Calton Avenue and Turney Road;

DULWICH WOOD AVENUE, (i) on both sides at its junction with Gipsy Hill, (ii) the carriageway located to the south of the triangular island site opposite Nos. 1-12 'The Garvens' and Nos. 53-55 Dulwich Wood Avenue, throughout the north side, (iii) on all sides at the western and eastern junctions with the carriageway located to the south of the triangular island site opposite Nos. 1-12 'The Garvens' and Nos. 53-55 Dulwich Wood Avenue, (iv) on the north-east side at its junction with Rusholme Grove, and (v) on the south-west side at its junction with Colby Road;

FARQUHAR ROAD (i) on the south-west side at its junction with Dulwich Wood Avenue, (ii) on the east side at its northern junction with Jasper Road, and (iii) on the north-east side at its southern junction with Jasper Road;

JASPER ROAD, on both sides at its southern junction with Farquhar Road;

TOWNLEY ROAD, on the north-east side at its junction with Calton Avenue;

TURNEY ROAD, (i) on the north-west side between its junction with Dulwich Village and its eastern junction with Roseway, (ii) on the north-west side at its western junction with Roseway, (iii) on the south-east side between its junctions with Dulwich Village and Boxall Road, (iv) on both sides at its junction with Pickwick Road; (v) on both sides at its junction with Burbage Road, (vi) on the south-east side at the vehicular access to Dulwich Sports Ground; and (vii) on both sides at its junction with Croxted Road;

WOODWARDE ROAD, on both sides at its junction with Calton Avenue;

- (g) to introduce loading restrictions which would operate between 7 am to 10 am and 4 pm to 7 pm on Mondays to Fridays in CALTON AVENUE on both sides between a point 14.2 metres north-east of the north-eastern wall of No. 1d Calton Avenue and its junction with Dulwich Village;
- (h) to relocate an existing car club parking place from the south-east side of Calton Avenue to the north-east side of GILKES CRESCENT, at the side of No. 7 Calton Avenue;
- to provide a new loading bay, 10.1 metres in length, which would operate between Midnight and 7 am, 10 am and 4 pm and 7 pm and Midnight on Mondays to Fridays and at any time on Saturdays and Sundays, in CALTON AVENUE on the north-west side outside No. 1d Calton Avenue;
- (j) to reduce in length and formalise the existing free echelon parking places on the north-east side of DULWICH VILLAGE outside Nos. 25-49 Dulwich Village;
- (k) to update the designation of the existing segregated southbound contra-flow cycle lane in FARQUHAR ROAD between its southern junction with Jasper Road and Crystal Palace Parade, and to update the existing one-way traffic working provision for vehicles other than pedal cycles in the adjoining carriageway; and
- (I) to formalise an existing cycle track on a footpath at the following location:-

GREEN DALE, a segregated cycle track for the use of pedal cycles only, comprising all that part of the footpath as is bounded on the north-east by the north-eastern edge of that footpath and on the south-west by a line drawn at least 1.5 metres south-west of and parallel to that north-eastern edge and marked by a segregating kerb, as extends from the south-eastern kerb-line of the vehicular access to No. 65 Green Dale to the north-western kerb-line of the vehicular access to Greendale Close.

3. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE that it has approved under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the provision of 'zebra' pedestrian crossings at the following locations:-

CALTON AVENUE, the centre of which would be located at the common boundary of Nos. 31 and 33 Calton Avenue. Zig-zag markings, on which vehicles would be prohibited from stopping at all times, would be laid on the north-west side for a distance of 6.5 metres north-east of and 17.5 metres south-west of the crossing, and on the south-east side for a distance of 14 metres north-east of and 7 metres south-west of the crossing; and

TURNEY ROAD, the centre of which would be located 11 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Boxall Road. Zig-zag markings, on which vehicles would be prohibited from stopping at all times, would be laid on the north-west side for a distance of 6.5 metres north-east of and 10 metres south-west of the crossing, and on the south-east side for a distance of 10 metres either side of the crossing.

- 4. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980<sup>4</sup> and in accordance with the provisions of the Highways (Road humps) Regulations 1999<sup>5</sup> and the Highways (Traffic calming) Regulations 1999<sup>6</sup>, propose to construct:-
  - (a) speed tables of flat-top construction having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the entire width of the carriageway, in:-

COURT LANE, at its junction with Calton Avenue, extending from a point 1 metre metres south-east of the south-eastern wall of No. 1b Court Lane north-westward for a distance of 9.5 metres, measured on the north-east side of Court Lane;

DULWICH WOOD AVENUE, at its junction with Farquhar Road, extending from the south-western kerb-line of Farquhar Road south-westward for a distance of 13 metres, measured on the north-west side of Dulwich Wood Avenue; and

WOODWARDE ROAD, at its junction with Calton Avenue, extending from the south-eastern kerb-line of Calton Avenue south-eastward for a distance of 9 metres, measured on the north-east side of Woodwarde Road.

(b) road humps of sinusoidal cross-section construction, 3.7 metres in length, having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the greater width of the carriageway, centred upon the following locations:-

DULWICH WOOD AVENUE, at a point 6.1 metres north-west of the common boundary of Nos. 49 and 51 Dulwich Wood Avenue;

DULWICH WOOD AVENUE, at a point 2.2 metres north-west of the common boundary of Nos. 37 and 39 Dulwich Wood Avenue;

DULWICH WOOD AVENUE, at a point 29.8 metres south-east of the southeastern wall of No. 29 Dulwich Wood Avenue;

DULWICH WOOD AVENUE, at a point 11.5 metres south-east of the southeastern kerb-line of Colby Road;

DULWICH WOOD AVENUE, at a point 3 metres north-east of the common boundary of Nos. 7 and 9 Dulwich Wood Avenue;

FARQUHAR ROAD, at a point 22.6 metres north-west of the north-western kerbline build-out of Dulwich Wood Avenue; FARQUHAR ROAD, at a point 33.7 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerbline build-out of Dulwich Wood Avenue;

FARQUHAR ROAD, at a point 35 metres north of the north-western kerb-line build-out of Jasper Road, at its northern junction with Farquhar Road;

FARQUHAR ROAD, at a point 5 metres south of the south-eastern kerb-line of Jasper Road, at its northern junction with Farquhar Road;

FARQUHAR ROAD, at a point 12.5 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Bowley Lane;

FARQUHAR ROAD, at a point 23 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Jasper Road, at its southern junction with Farquhar Road;

FARQUHAR ROAD, at a point 44.5 metres south-west of the south-western kerbline of Jasper Road, at its southern junction with Farquhar Road;

TURNEY ROAD, at a point 1.7 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos. 242 and 244 Turney Road;

TURNEY ROAD, at a point 2.8 metres north-east of the common boundary of Nos. 224 and 226 Turney Road; and

TURNEY ROAD, at a point 0.6 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos. 112 and 114 Turney Road.

Existing speed cushions at these locations would be removed.

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# **Statement of reasons**

# Pedal cycle 'Quietway' route Q7: Green Dale to Farquhar Road

The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed routes) (Pedal cycle quietways) (No. \*) Traffic Order 201\*

The London Borough of Southwark Cycle Tracks Order (Pedal cycle quietways) (No. \*) 201\* The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (Car club) (No. \*) Order 201\* The London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (No. \*) Order 201\* The London Borough of Southwark (Loading bays) (No. \*) Order 201\* The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. \*) Order 201\*

- 1. Quietways are a network of improved streets across London designed to make it easier for less confident people to cycle by calming traffic and ensuring streets are safer and improved for all road users. The measures include safer junctions, improved crossings for pedestrians, more efficient signal junctions, and a more pleasant street environment.
- 2. In Southwark there are six Quietways. Southwark's Quietway route network was adopted by the council's Cabinet as part of its Cycling Strategy in June 2015. The entire budget allocated to Southwark by Transport for London to deliver the Quietways network is £12m. Quietway 7 is part of phase 1 of the Quietway network and runs from Elephant & Castle to Crystal Palace. In Southwark the route will run from Falmouth Road via Portland Street, Burgess Park, Camberwell Grove, Calton Avenue, across Dulwich Village junction, across Croxted Road into Lambeth and back to Southwark via Dulwich Wood Avenue, ending at Farquhar Road / Crystal Palace Parade junction.
- 3. The first phase of Quietway routes across London were chosen for the following reasons:
  - Met the Quietways criteria,
  - Buildable by March 2017
  - Included a good geographical spread linking key destinations across 17 London boroughs
  - Demonstrated different Quietways characteristics, e.g. routes through parks, existing cycle routes, different levels of interventions needed, or complementing existing and planned infrastructure
- 4. With an emphasis on improving safety for all road users , the key benefits of Quietway 7 are outlined below:

# Pedestrians and school children:

- Safer walking environment by measures that enforce the borough wide 20mph speed limit, i.e. improved traffic calming.
- Providing safer pedestrian crossings.
- Safer crossings at junctions e.g. double yellow lines to improve visibility at blind spots.
- Measures to reinforce priority for pedestrians at informal crossings eg improved signage and visibility, and change in paving material at crossing locations.
- Wider footways around school entrances.
- Reduced crossing distance at junctions.
- Improve footway surfacing where needed.
- Take advantage to declutter and rationalise street furniture making the environment more pleasant.

### Cyclists:

• Provide segregation for cyclists at busy junctions.

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- Cyclists having their own signal phase, not mixing with traffic at busy junctions, such as the Portland Street / Albany Road junction.
- Segregated mandatory cycle contra flow where cycling uphill.
- · Cycle friendly traffic calming measures.
- · Resurface carriageway where needed.
- Safer junctions with double yellow lines.
- Removing pinch points.

#### Drivers:

- Remove pinch points which impede traffic flow.
- Reduce delays at signal junctions .eg Portland Street / Albany Road.
- Encourage safer driving behaviours with the introduction of additional traffic calming measures where necessary.
- Improve safety at junctions and safer parking practice.

#### Improving the streetscene:

- Introduce street greening where possible.
- Declutter and rationalise street furniture.
- Resurface carriageway / footway where required.

The council of the London Borough of Southwark, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

1.1This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed routes) (Pedal cycle<br/>quietways) (No. \*) Traffic Order 2017, shall come into force on2017.

#### **Interpretation**

2.1 In this Order:-

causing includes permitting;

"cycle lane" means an area of carriageway within a length of street specified in the Schedule to this Order which is indicated by a traffic sign as being a cycle lane for the use of pedal cycles only, subject to the provisions of this Order;

"Dulwich Wood Avenue cycle lane" means the cycle lane described in item 3 of the Schedule to this Order;

"electronic communications network" has the same meaning as that given in section 32 of the Communications Act 2003<sup>b</sup>;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"Farquhar Road segregated cycle lane" means the segregated cycle lane described in item 5 of the Schedule to this Order;

"kerb-line" means the imaginary line which is the projection of the line formed by the edge of the carriageway of a street;

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 185(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1988<sup>c</sup> and section 136(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>d</sup>;

"prescribed street", for the purposes of Article 4.1(c) means any street or part of street referred to in Article 3 or 4 of this Order;

"traffic sign" means a sign of any size, type and colour prescribed and authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

#### Prescribed routes

- 3.1 No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that part of the carriageway of Farquhar Road which lies to the south-west and north-west of the Farquhar Road segregated cycle lane and between the north-western kerb-line of Crystal Palace Parade and the south-western kerb-line of Jasper Road (at its southern junction with Farquhar Road) in a direction other than from south-east to north-east.
- 3.2 No person causing any vehicle other than a pedal cycle to proceed in that part of Farquhar Road which lies to the north-east of its southern junction with Jasper Road or in Jasper Road shall, upon reaching the southern junction of Jasper Road and Farquhar Road, cause that vehicle to enter into that part of Farquhar Road which lies to the south-west of that junction.
- 3.3 No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that part of the carriageway of the arm of Dulwich Wood Avenue located to the south of the triangular island site opposite Nos. 1-12 'The Garvens' and Nos. 53-55 Dulwich Wood Avenue which lies to the south of the Dulwich Wood Avenue cycle lane in a direction other than from east to west.
- 3.4 No person causing any vehicle other than a pedal cycle to proceed in that part of Dulwich Wood Avenue which lies between its junction with Gipsy Hill and the arm of Dulwich Wood Avenue located to the south of the triangular island site opposite Nos. 1-12 'The Garvens' and Nos. 53-55 Dulwich Wood Avenue shall, upon reaching the its junction with the arm of Dulwich Wood Avenue located to the south of the triangular island site opposite Nos. 1-12 'The Garvens' and Nos. 53-55 Dulwich Wood Avenue, cause that vehicle to enter into the arm of Dulwich Wood Avenue located to the south of the triangular island site opposite Nos. 1-12 'The Garvens' and Nos. 53-55 Dulwich Wood Avenue, cause that vehicle to enter into the arm of Dulwich Wood Avenue located to the south of the triangular island site opposite Nos. 1-12 'The Garvens' and Nos. 53-55 Dulwich Wood Avenue.

#### Cycle lanes

- 4.1 No person shall cause any vehicle other than a pedal cycle to enter into or proceed in a cycle lane specified in the Schedule to this Order at any time.
- 4.2 Every person causing a pedal cycle to proceed in a cycle lane specified in the Schedule to this Order shall, where a direction of travel other than 'two-way' is specified column (3) of the item relating to that cycle lane, cause that pedal cycle to proceed in the direction of travel so specified.

#### Exemptions

- 5.1 Nothing in Articles 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.4, 4.1 and 4.2 above shall apply in relation to:-
  - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
  - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
  - (c) any vehicle being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to a prescribed street of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or of any electronic communications network; or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign, if the vehicle cannot be used for that purpose in any other street or part of that street; or

- (d) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 5.2 Nothing in Article 4.1 above shall apply in relation to any vehicle entering into a cycle lane specified in the Schedule to this Order for as long as necessary:-
  - (a) to enable access to or exit from any road adjoining that cycle lane, or enable access to or exit from any premises adjoining that cycle lane by way of a vehicular access or footway crossover, or to enable access to or exit from any designated parking place or any designated loading bay adjoining that cycle lane, provided that vehicle leaves the cycle lane immediately thereafter;
  - (b) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle; or
  - (c) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, if and in so far as the activity is not prohibited by the provisions of any other Order; or
  - (d) for the purpose of collecting refuse; or
  - (e) for the purposes of the provision of a universal postal service (as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000<sup>e</sup>) provided the vehicle bears the livery of a universal postal service provider.

#### Amendment of existing order

6.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done, or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the London Borough of Southwark (Cycle Lane) (No. 2) Traffic Order 1996<sup>f</sup> shall have effect as though the items numbered 11 and 14 in Schedule 1 therein were omitted.
