- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be:-
  - (a) to prohibit all southbound vehicles except pedal cycles in RODNEY PLACE from turning right into Heygate Street;
  - (b) to introduce new or extend existing lengths of 'at any time' waiting restrictions in:-

BENHILL ROAD: (i) on the east side at its junction with Owgan Close, (i) on both sides at its junction with Elmington Road, (iii) on both sides at its junctions with Vicarage Grove and Brunswick Park,

BRUNSWICK PARK, on both sides at its junction with Benhill Road;

ELMINGTON ROAD, on both sides at its junction with Benhill Road;

GRACE'S ROAD: (i) on the north-west side at its junction with Wilson Road and (ii) on both sides at its junction with Grace's Mews;

VICARAGE GROVE, on both sides at its junction with Benhill Road;

WILSON ROAD: (i) on the north-east side at its junction with Maude Road, (ii) on the north-east side outside Nos. 26-29 Wilson Road, (iii) on both sides at its junction with Grace's Road;

(c) to reduce in length existing permit holders' parking places in:-

BENHILL ROAD: (i) on the east side at the rear of Nos. 1-35 Owgan Close, (ii) on the east side at the flank wall of No. 32 Elmington Road, (iii) on the east side at the flank wall of No. 22 Brunswick Park, (iv) on the east side at the flank wall of No. 21 Brunswick Park, (v) on the west side outside Nos. 108-112 Benhill Road, (vi) on the west side at the flank wall of No. 42 Vicarage Grove, and (vii) on the west side at the rear of Nos. 43-52 Vicarage Grove;

ELMINGTON ROAD, on the south-east side outside No. 130 Elmington Road;

GRACE'S ROAD: (i) on the north-west side at the flank wall of No. 29 Wilson Road, and (ii) on the south-east side outside No. 77 Grace's Road;

VICARAGE GROVE: (i) on the north side outside No. 42 Vicarage Grove, and (ii) on the south side at the flank wall of No. 43 Vicarage Grove;

- WILSON ROAD: (i) on the north-east side outside Nos. 16-17 Wilson Road, (ii) on the north-east side outside Nos. 18-19 Wilson Road, and (iii) on the southwest side outside No. 30 Wilson Road:
- (d) to remove an existing permit holders' parking place in WILSON ROAD on the north-east side outside Nos. 26-29 Wilson Road;
- (e) to reduce in length an existing 'shared use' parking place in GRACE'S ROAD on the north-west side at the flank wall of No. 30 Wilson Road;
- (f) to relocate northward by 4.6 metres an existing car club parking place in BENHILL ROAD, on the west side at the flank wall of No. 42 Vicarage Grove; and
- (g) to amend the designation of existing permit holders' parking places in ADDINGTON SQUARE, BENHILL ROAD and BRUNSWICK PARK so as to allow for the new footway and carriageway layout in the 'quietway' route.
- 3. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE that it has approved under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the provision of a raised 'zebra' pedestrian crossing with a parallel cycle crossing facility at the following location:-
  - NEW CHURCH ROAD, the centre of which would be located 9.5 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Addington Square (the south-eastern arm).
  - Zig-zag markings, on which vehicles would be prohibited from stopping at all times, would be laid on both sides of the road for a distance of 21.5 metres north-east of and 9 metres south-west of the crossing.
- 4. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980<sup>2</sup> and in accordance with the provisions of the Highways (Road humps) Regulations 1999<sup>3</sup> and the Highways (Traffic calming) Regulations 1999<sup>4</sup>, propose to construct:-
  - (a) a speed table of flat-top construction having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the entire width of the carriageway, in NEW CHURCH ROAD, at the 'zebra' pedestrian crossing location referred to in item 3 above, extending from a point 6.1 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Addington Square (the south-eastern arm) north-eastward for a distance of 6.7 metres.
  - (b) road humps of sinusoidal cross-section construction, 3.7 metres in length, having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the greater width of the carriageway, centred upon the following locations:-

BENHILL ROAD, at a point 29 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line build-out of Picton Street;

BENHILL ROAD, at a point 19.5 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Owgan Close:

BENHILL ROAD, at a point 25 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Elmington Road;

BENHILL ROAD, at a point 13.5 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Elmington Road;

BENHILL ROAD, at a point 0.5 metres south of the common boundary of Nos. 117 and 119 Benhill Road;

BENHILL ROAD, at a point 1 metre south of the common boundary of Nos. 137 and 139 Benhill Road;

BENHILL ROAD, at a point 2 metres south of the southern wall of No. 151 Benhill Road;

BENHILL ROAD, at a point 31.5 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Brunswick Park:

BENHILL ROAD, at a point 5 metres south of the southern wall of No. 161 Benhill Road:

BENHILL ROAD, at a point 22 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Peckham Road:

EDMUND STREET, at a point 23.5 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line build-out of Picton Street;

WILSON ROAD, at a point 25 metres south-east of the southern kerb-line of Peckham Road:

WILSON ROAD, at a point 12 metres north-west of the north-western wall of No. 4 Wilson Road:

WILSON ROAD, at a point 2 metres south-east of the common boundary of Nos. 13 and 14 Wilson Road; and

WILSON ROAD, at a point 1.5 metres south-east of the common boundary of Nos. 22 and 23 Wilson Road.

Existing speed cushions at these locations would be removed.

- 1. Quietways are a network of improved streets across London designed to make it easier for less confident people to cycle by calming traffic and ensuring streets are safer and improved for all road users. The measures include safer junctions, improved crossings for pedestrians, more efficient signal junctions, and a more pleasant street environment.
- 2. In Southwark there are six Quietways. Southwark's Quietway route network was adopted by the council's Cabinet as part of its Cycling Strategy in June 2015. The entire budget allocated to Southwark by Transport for London to deliver the Quietways network is £12m. Quietway 7 is part of phase 1 of the Quietway network and runs from Elephant & Castle to Crystal Palace. In Southwark the route will run from Falmouth Road via Portland Street, Burgess Park, Camberwell Grove, Calton Avenue, across Dulwich Village junction, across Croxted Road into Lambeth and back to Southwark via Dulwich Wood Avenue, ending at Farquhar Road / Crystal Palace Parade junction.
- 3. The first phase of Quietway routes across London were chosen for the following reasons:
  - Met the Quietways criteria,
  - Buildable by March 2017
  - Included a good geographical spread linking key destinations across 17 London boroughs
  - Demonstrated different Quietways characteristics, e.g. routes through parks, existing cycle routes, different levels of interventions needed, or complementing existing and planned infrastructure
- 4. With an emphasis on improving safety for all road users, the key benefits of Quietway 7 are outlined below:

#### Pedestrians and school children:

- Safer walking environment by measures that enforce the borough wide 20mph speed limit, i.e. improved traffic calming.
- Providing safer pedestrian crossings.
- Safer crossings at junctions e.g. double yellow lines to improve visibility at blind spots.
- Measures to reinforce priority for pedestrians at informal crossings eg improved signage and visibility, and change in paving material at crossing locations.
- Wider footways around school entrances.
- Reduced crossing distance at junctions.
- · Improve footway surfacing where needed.
- Take advantage to declutter and rationalise street furniture making the environment more pleasant.

#### Cyclists:

- Provide segregation for cyclists at busy junctions.
- Cyclists having their own signal phase, not mixing with traffic at busy junctions, such as the Portland Street / Albany Road junction.
- Segregated mandatory cycle contra flow where cycling uphill.
- Cycle friendly traffic calming measures.
- Resurface carriageway where needed.
- · Safer junctions with double yellow lines.
- Removing pinch points.

#### **Drivers:**

- · Remove pinch points which impede traffic flow.
- Reduce delays at signal junctions .eg Portland Street / Albany Road.
- Encourage safer driving behaviours with the introduction of additional traffic calming measures where necessary.
- Improve safety at junctions and safer parking practice.

#### Improving the streetscene:

- · Introduce street greening where possible.
- Declutter and rationalise street furniture.
- Resurface carriageway / footway where required.

The council of the London Borough of Southwark, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed routes) (Pedal cycle quietways) (No. \*) Traffic Order 2017, shall come into force on 2017.

#### Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

causing includes permitting;

"electronic communications network" has the same meaning as that given in section 32 of the Communications Act 2003<sup>b</sup>;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"kerb-line" means the imaginary line which is the projection of the line formed by the edge of the carriageway of a street;

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>c</sup>;

"prescribed street", for the purposes of Article 4.1(c) means any street or part of street referred to in Article 3 or 4 of this Order;

"traffic sign" means a sign of any size, type and colour prescribed and authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Any reference in this Order to a named road, street or part thereof shall be construed as a reference to road or street which lies within the London Borough of Southwark.

#### Prescribed routes

3.1 No person causing any vehicle other than a pedal cycle to proceed in a southbound direction in Rodney Place shall, upon reaching its junction with Heygate Street and Rodney Road, cause that vehicle to turn right into Heygate Street.

#### **Exemptions**

- 4.1 Nothing in Articles 3.1 above shall apply in relation to:-
  - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
  - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
  - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2016 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

#### Revocation

3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done, or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the designation by the Order of 2016 of the parking places numbered 10, 11, 16, 17, 18, 19, 21, 22, 30, 31, 58, 131 and 133 and set out in Schedule 1 to that Order, is hereby revoked.

#### Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2016 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in columns (2) and (3) of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2016 (other than Articles 3 and 15) shall apply to the areas described in the Schedule to this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a designated parking place or to a parking place shall include a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2016 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

#### Placing of traffic signs, etc.

- 5.1 The council shall:-
  - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order;
  - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order traffic signs indicating that such parking places may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Articles 4.1 and 4.2 of the Order of 2016;
  - (c) carry out such other works as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

#### Revocation

- 3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order:-
  - (a) the designation by the Order of 2011 of the parking places numbered 18, 23, 36, 37, 38, and 40 and set out in Schedule 1 therein is hereby revoked; and
  - (b) the designation by the London Borough of Southwark (Parking Places) (CPZ 'LG') (No. 2) Order 2012° of the parking place numbered 12 and set out in the Schedule therein is hereby revoked.

#### Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2011 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column (2) of a Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, and, unless otherwise specified, having a width throughout of 2 metres, is designated as a parking place.
