The London Borough of Southwark ("the Council") makes this Order in exercise of its powers under Section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) ("the Act") and all other enabling powers.


1. The Council authorises the stopping up of the areas of highway described in the Schedule to this Order and shown hatched black on the plan attached hereto.
2. This Order is made to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted by the Council on 14 October 2016 under local planning authority reference number No. 16/AP/3281 for:-

*'Change of use and part retention/demolition of No 201 to provide 1 x 3 bed house (Use Class C3) and demolition of No.s 203-205 and the erection of a new building comprising 8 x residential apartments (Use Class C3) and associated landscaping, cycling and refuse storage facilities.'*

3. This Order shall come into force on the date on which notice that it has been made is first published in accordance with Section 252 (10) of the Act, and may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Crystal Palace Road) Stopping Up Order (No.5) 2017.


