

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of the following areas of public highway shown hatched black on the plan attached to the draft Order:-

1. *The highway known as New Church Road from the junction with Southampton Way to the junction with Wells Way measuring approximately 359.02m in length and varying between a minimum width of 9.64m and maximum width of 18m.*

All of the areas to be stopped up fall within the London Borough of Southwark

IF THE ORDER IS MADE the stopping up will be authorised to enable the development described in the Schedule to this Notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted under Part III of the Act by the Council on 30 November 2016 under local planning authority reference No. 16/AP/3165.
