## Canada Water Site C+E - junction improvements

The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed route) (Surrey Quays Road) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2017 The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed route) (Maritime Street) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2017

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be, in:-
  - (a) MARITIME STREET to impose compulsory right turns for all vehicles except pedal cycles approaching Surrey Quays Road from Maritime Street; and
  - (b) SURREY QUAYS ROAD to prohibit all vehicles except pedal cycles from turning right to enter Maritime Street at its junction with Surrey Quays Road, in the London Borough of Southwark.
