- 2. This Order is made to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted by the Council on 30 November 2016 under local planning authority reference number No. 16/AP/3165 for:-

'Re-landscaping the South-West region of Burgess Park including a new play area, new access pathways, new lighting fixtures, new surfaces, trees, shrubs, meadow and to include new park furniture."

3. This Order shall come into force on the date on which notice that it has been made is first published in accordance with Section 252 (10) of the Act, and may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (New Church Road) Stopping Up Order (No. 3) 2017.


