Fetal Medicine Research Institute - Windsor Walk: proposed on-street parking amendments

The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'L') (No. 2) Order 2017
The London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (No. 16) Order 2017
The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. 47) Order 2017

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders, so as to provide a short-term pick up/set down parking facility for patients of and visitors to the new Fetal Medicine Research Institute at Nos. 16-20 Windsor Walk, would be, in WINDSOR WALK:-
 - (a) to provide a new free short-stay parking place on the north-west side outside Nos. 16-20 Windsor Walk, 29.2 metres in length, in which vehicles may park free of charge for up to 20 minutes at any time, provided that no vehicle may return to that parking place within 1 hour;
 - (b) to remove the existing CPZ 'L' shared-use parking place at the above location so as to accommodate the new free parking place; and
 - (c) to amend existing waiting restriction definitions so as to accommodate the new on-street parking layout.
