Made this 21st day of September 2021


The London Borough of Southwark ("the Council") makes this Order in exercise of its powers under Section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) ("the Act") and all other enabling powers.

1. The Council authorises the stopping up of the area of highway described in the Schedule to this Order and which is shown hatched black on the drawing attached hereto and labelled Lovegrove Street Stopping Up Area 01.
2. This Order is made to enable the following development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted by the Council on 4 March 2021 under local planning authority reference number No. 20/AP/0188:-

'Construction of two joined two storey buildings arranged in an L-shape following the street layout on the junction of Old Kent Road with St. James's Road. The use class will include B1, D1,D2 with ancillary use classes A1, A3, A4, A5.'

3. This Order shall come into force on the date on which notice that it has been made is first published in accordance with Section 252 (10) of the Act, and may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Lovegrove Street) Stopping Up Order 2021.

An irregular shaped area of highway at Lovegrove Street which measures 24.209 metres in length (at its longest point) and 9.313 metres in width (at its widest point).
