

## **Public notice**

### **Artichoke Place**

The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment (No. \*) Order 201\*

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be in ARTICHOKE PLACE -
  - (a) to introduce 'at any time' waiting restrictions on both sides, including its north-western extremity, from a point 5.2 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Camberwell Church Street;
  - (b) to introduce 'at any time' loading restrictions on: (i) the full-length of its north-eastern extremity;
  - (ii) the north-west side, from its north-eastern extremity southward to a point 19 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Camberwell Church Street; and (iii) the south-west side, from its north-eastern extremity a point 5.2 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Camberwell Church Street.
- 3. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980<sup>2</sup> and in accordance with the provisions of the Highways (Road humps) Regulations 1999<sup>3</sup> and the Highways (Traffic calming) Regulations 1999<sup>4</sup>, propose to construct speed tables of flat-top construction having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the entire width of the carriageway, at the following locations:-

ARTICHOKE PLACE all parts of the public highway – extending from the north-eastern kerb-line of Camberwell Church Street north-eastwards to its north-eastern extremity; and

KIMPTON ROAD – extending from a point 21 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Camberwell Church Street north-eastwards for a distance of 15.5 metres.

Note: these measures would replace any existing speed tables, speed cushions or road humps at or in the immediate vicinity of the above locations.

## Statement of reasons

### **Artichoke Place**

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Part of the recommendations approved for Camberwell Pocket Places and Camberwell Town Centre (approved in 2017) Artichoke Place, and the areas surrounding the Camberwell Leisure Centre and its car-park, have a series of improvements planned.

These include new carriageway and footway layout to accommodate a new communal area with cycle stands, outdoor seating and planting in Artichoke Place directly outside the Camberwell Leisure Centre.

The Camberwell Leisure Centre car-park will have access from Kimpton Road only, as to encourage a more pedestrian and cycle-friendly zone surrounding the Camberwell Leisure Centre building in Artichoke Place.

Raised speed tables, of flat-top design, will be constructed in the entirety of Artichoke Place, and over the section of public highway in Kimpton Road that provides access to the Camberwell Leisure Centre car-park.



The council of the London Borough of Southwark, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

### Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. \*\*) Order 2018 and shall come into force on 2018.

#### Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

- "the Order of 2015" means the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) Consolidation Order 2015<sup>b</sup>, as amended by the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. 14) Order 2016<sup>c</sup>.
- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2015 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

- 3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done, or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Order of 2015 shall have effect as though: -
- (i) there were added to Schedule 1 to that Order the items numbered \*\*\*\* and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order; and
- (ii) there were added to Schedule 2 to that Order the items numbered \*\*\*\* and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order.
