- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be in NELSON SQUARE:-
 - (a) the northern arm outside Nos. 52-156 Rowland Hill House, Nelson Square, to:
 - (i) formalise lengths of existing single yellow line waiting restrictions on the north, north-west, south, south-east and southwest sides; (ii) formalise lengths of existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the north and south sides; (iii) to remove 5 metres of existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the north side to reduce the net loss of 'C1' permit holders' parking places, and (iv) to reduce overall in length by 8 metres an existing 'C1' permit holders' parking place on the north side, so as to accommodate a raised speed table;
 - (b) the eastern arm outside Nos. 157-209 Applegarth House, Nelson Square, to:
 - (i) formalise lengths of existing single yellow line waiting restrictions on the east and west sides; (ii) formalise lengths of existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the east and west sides; (iii) to remove 4 metres of existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the east side to reduce the net loss of 'C1' permit holders' parking places, and (iv) to reduce overall in length by 1.1 metres an existing 'C1' permit holders' parking place on the east side, so as to accommodate a raised speed table;
 - (c) the southern arm outside Nos. 222-269 Helen Gladstone House, Nelson Square, to formalise:
 - (i) lengths of existing single yellow line waiting restrictions on the north and south sides; (ii) lengths of 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the north and south sides; (iii) the reduction in length by 15.2 metres of the existing 'C1' permit holders' parking place on the south side; and (iv) the increase in length, to 6.6 metres, and relocation eastwards (by a distance of 14.5 metres) the existing 'unlimited stay' disabled persons' (blue badge-holders') parking place, so as to accommodate a raised speed table; and
 - (d) the western arm outside Nos. 1-51 Vaughan House, Nelson Square, to:
 - (i) formalise lengths of existing single yellow line waiting restrictions on the east and west sides; (ii) formalise lengths of 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the east and west sides; (iii) to remove 4 metres of existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the west side to reduce the net loss of 'C1' permit holders' parking places, and (iv) to reduce overall in length by 10 metres an existing 'C1' permit holders' parking place on the west side, so as to accommodate a raised speed table.
- 3. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980² and in accordance with the provisions of the Highways (Road humps) Regulations 1999³ and the Highways (Traffic calming) Regulations 1999⁴, that it formalises existing speed tables of flat-top construction, having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the entire width of the carriageway in NELSON SQUARE:-
 - (a) the northern arm, extending from a point 16.5 metres west of the common boundary of Nos. 52-156 Rowland Hill House, Nelson Square and The Lord Nelson PH, Union Street westwards for a distance of 9.7 metres;
 - (b) the eastern arm, extending from a point 11 metres north of the southern wall of Nos. 157-209 Applegarth House, Nelson Square northwards for a distance of 7.2 metres;
 - (c) the southern arm, extending from a point 7.7 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of vehicular access to Nos. 222-269 Helen Gladstone House, Nelson Square eastwards for a distance of 7.2 metres; and
 - (d) the western arm, extending from a point 7.6 metres south of the northern wall of Nos. 1-51 Vaughan House, Nelson Square southwards for a distance of 7.2 metres.
 - Note: these measures would replace any existing speed tables, speed cushions or road humps at or in the immediate vicinity of the above locations.

Nelson Square improvements

The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'C1') (No. *) Order 201*

The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 201*

Nelson Square is located in the Borough & Bankside ward of the London Borough of Southwark.

Nelson Square completely surrounds Nelson Square Garden, which is a popular public play area for residents and visitors. This scheme aims to make the best use of carriageway by i) formalising measures set in place to improve the safety and accessibility for pedestrians as well as, ii) maximising the amount of on-street permit parking places made available to the surrounding housing.


This scheme proposes to:


- formalise existing raised (flat-topped design) speed tables, which reduce vehicle speeds and provide level-access to and from Nelson Square Garden;
- formalise and amend existing parking bays, to increase the amount of permit holder's parking places in zone 'C1' to provide a net parking increase in length of approx. 13 metres, a figure that was reduced overall by the recent changes to the pedestrian access; and
- amend existing waiting restrictions, to accommodate the above changes.



Revocation

3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done, or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order the designation by the Order of 2012 of the parking places numbered 34, 35, 36 and 37 in Schedule 1 therein, is hereby revoked.

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2012 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in columns (2) and (3) of a Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2012 (other than Articles 3 and 15) shall apply to the areas described in each Schedule to this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a designated parking place or to a parking place shall include a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2012 included a reference to Schedule 1 to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs, etc.

- 5.1 The council shall:-
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in Schedule 1 or 2 to this Order;
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule 1 or 2 to this Order traffic signs indicating that such parking places may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Articles 4.1 and 4.3 or 4.4, as the case may be, of the Order of 2012;
 - (c) carry out such other works as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.
