- Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be:-
- (a) to provide new disabled persons parking places, 6 metres in length unless otherwise stated, which would operate at any time and may be used without time limit by vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons 'blue badge', at the following locations:-

ALBRIGHTON ROAD, on the south-west side outside 1 to 21 Tidworth House, East Dulwich Estate;

ASTBURY ROAD, on the west side outside No. 22 Astbury Road;

BARRY ROAD, (i) on the south-east side *outside* the common boundary of Nos. 239 and 241 Barry Road; (ii) on the south-east side *outside* No. 57 Barry Road;

BARTHOLOMEW STREET, on the north-west side outside No. 11 Bartholomew Street;

CREDON ROAD; on the west side outside No. 42 Credon Road;

HARLESCOTT ROAD, on the south-east side outside No. 61 Harlescott Road;

MEETING HOUSE LANE, on the north-west side outside No. 26 Meeting House Lane;

QUEBEC WAY, on the south-west side (12 metres in length) opposite Bay House, No. 12 Quebec Way;

RADNOR ROAD, on the north-east side outside No. 7 Radnor Road;

RODWELL ROAD, on the north side outside No. 72 Rodwell Road;

ST HELENA ROAD, on the south-east side outside No. 82 St Helena Road; and

YORK GROVE, on the south-east side outside the western wall of No. 219 Queen's Road;

The measures in 2 b-d are proposed so as to accommodate the provision of the new disabled persons parking places referred to above.

- (b) to split an existing permit holders' parking place in BARTHOLOMEW STREET (in CPZ 'D');
- (c) to reduce in length an existing permit holders' parking place in ST HELENA ROAD (in CPZ 'N');
- (d) to remove 12 metres of existing double yellow lines 'at any time' waiting restrictions in QUEBEC WAY; and
- (e) to remove disabled persons parking places that are no longer needed in Camberwell Grove, Carden Road, Copleston Road, Costa Street, Date Street (3 locations), Ferris Road, Glengarry Road, Goodrich Road, Hansler Road, Kimberley Avenue, Limesford Road, Lynton Road, Reverdy Road, Ruskin Walk, Sedgmoor Place, South Croxted Road, Sydenham Hill and Urlwin Street.
