

## LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

**THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK** hereby gives notice that it has made an order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of the following area of public highway which is shown hatched black on the plan attached to the draft order:

The area of public highway to be stopped up is the rear of footway on the north side of Great Suffolk Street adjacent to the Grotto Podiums Open Space from the edge of the perimeter fence at the open space adjacent to King's Court to the edge of the perimeter fence dividing the sports area from the public seating area measuring approximately 25.3 metres in length and 3.7 metres in width.

**THE ORDER IS MADE**, to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted under Part III of the Act by the Council of the London Borough of Southwark on 2 November 2018 under local planning authority reference LBS No.17/AP/0367

## THE SCHEDULE

*Planning Permission ref. no. 17/AP/0367*

*Redevelopment of the Southwark Fire Station, 94 Southwark Bridge Road, London SE1 OEG Grotto Place and Grotto Podiums including alterations and extensions to listed buildings for a mixed use scheme to provide a new secondary school with 6th form (up to 1150 pupils), 199 residential units, 234 sqm of flexible commercial or community use (Class A1, A3, B1, D1, D2), a 139 sqm Gym (D2), associated landscape and public realm works, cycle parking, disabled parking and servicing access; and the redevelopment of land at Grotto Place for the provision of a new sports hall (1,452sqm) and external multi use games facility and landscaping.*
