- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be:- note: Measurements are in metres 'm' and are approximate, and 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) will henceforth be referred to as 'DYLs'.
- (a) in ASHBOURNE GROVE, on the north-western side (i) to introduce 8.5m DYLs outside No. 32 and 34 to accommodate an existing dropped kerb; and (ii) to replace 4m of DYLs at the side of Nos. 64-66 Lordship Lane with a new solo motor cycle parking place, in which motor cycles would be permitted to park at any time and without time limit;
- (b) in BEATON CLOSE, to introduce 8.7m of DYLs on its southern and western sides of its southern extremity, in front of Nos. 9-11 Beaton Close;
- (c) in CHANDLER WAY, to introduce 15m of DYLs on the north-east side outside St Luke's Church, Chandler Way;
- (d) in COLLEGE ROAD, to introduce DYLs on the south-west side outside No. 48 College Road (51m), and across its junction with Hitherwood Drive (22.5m);
- (e) in COURT LANE, on the north-east side to extend existing DYLs across its junction with Eastlands Crescent by 8.5m;
- (f) in DULWICH VILLAGE, (i) to introduce 47m of DYLs on the south-west side south of its junction with Village Way, and (ii) to extend the existing DYLs on the east side outside the 'Crown & Greyhound' Public House, No. 73 Dulwich Village by 10m;
- (g) in FIRBANK ROAD, to introduce 15m of DYLs on the north side across the vehicular entrance to Saskia Mews;
- (h) in GALLERY ROAD, (i) to introduce 35m of DYLs on the north-west side on either side of the controlled area of the existing zebra pedestrian crossing outside the Dulwich Preparatory School, (ii) to introduce new lengths of DYLs on the south-east and east side: to the south-west of the controlled area of the existing zebra pedestrian crossing outside the Dulwich Preparatory School (27m), and across the vehicular access route to Chapel Cottage (8.7m), and (iii) on the south-east side to extend an existing length of DYLs north-east of the Dulwich Preparatory School north-eastward by a distance of 35m;
- (i) in HOWLETTS ROAD, on the north-east side to convert an existing length of single yellow line to 8.6m of DYLs at its junction with Warmington Road;
- (j) in MILO ROAD, to introduce 16m of DYLs on both sides on either side of the existing lockable fire gate;
- (k) in SYDENHAM HILL, on the north and west side (i) to convert 7.5m of existing length of single yellow line waiting restrictions to DYLs to the north of Attleborough Court, (ii) to extend an existing length of DYL north-westward by 20m to cover the kerb between Woodsyre (at its southern junction with Sydenham Hill) and Rock Hill, and (iii) to introduce new lengths of DYLs: outside Attleborough Court (25m), outside Dunton Court (20m), across its junction with the access road to Beltwood House, No. 41 Sydenham Hill (19m), across its junction with Crouchmans Close (43m) and across its junction with Woodsyre (at its north-eastern junction with Sydenham Hill) (19.5m); and
- (I) to provide new disabled persons' parking places, 6 metres in length, which would operate at any time and may be used without time limit by vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons 'blue badge', at the following locations:- BEAUVAL ROAD, on the south-west side *outside* No. 18 Beauval Road; DUNSTANS ROAD, on the south-east side *outside* No. 127 Dunstans Road; PELLATT ROAD, on the south side *outside* No. 27 Pellatt Road; and THOMPSON ROAD, on the north side *outside* No. 40 Thompson Road.

Statement of reasons





The London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (Disabled persons) (No.*) Order 201* The London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (Solo motor cycles) (No. *) Order 201* The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 201*

A minor traffic scheme (or non-strategic traffic and highway improvement) is a small project where the council proposes to modify the existing Highway layout. This may include changes to waiting and loading restrictions, parking places, improved crossing facilities etc. *Note: All measurements are approximated and 'DYLs' refer to double yellow lines ('at any time' waiting restrictions)*.

This batch of schemes propose the following changes in the South of the London Borough of Southwark:-

ASHBOURNE GROVE (Goose Green)

- to accommodate needed motorcycle parking in the area it is recommended to install 4m solo motorcycle parking bay in which motor cycles would be permitted to park at any time and without time limit to account; and
- introduce 8.5m DYLs outside No. 32 and 34 to accommodate an existing dropped kerb.

BEATON CLOSE (Peckham)

- to install DYLs opposite an existing Disabled Persons' (blue-badge holder's) parking place, to prevent other vehicles parking and to enable the resident to enter and exit the bay safely.

CHANDLER WAY (Peckham)

- vehicles regularly park close to the vehicle crossover of St. Luke's Church, which obstruct vehicles safely leaving and entering the church; it is recommended to install 15m DYLs to prevent obstructive parking and maintain visibility.

COLLEGE ROAD (Dulwich Village)

- as part of a wider TfL junction improvement scheme it is recommended to introduce 22.5m of DYLs across its junction with Hitherwood Drive; and 51m of DYLs on College Road, to maintain access for the buses.

COURT LANE (Dulwich Village)

- it is recommended to extend the DYLs by 4.2m on both sides of the junction with Eastlands Crescent to prevent vehicles overhanging the vehicle crossover and to improve visibility.

DULWICH VILLAGE (Dulwich Village)

- for the safety of cyclists approaching the junction of Dulwich Village with Village Way, Red Post Hill and East Dulwich Grove it is recommended that 47m DYLs to be introduced to improve visibility and access for cyclists on the south-west side;
- to extend the existing DYLs on the east side outside the 'Crown & Greyhound' Public House, No. 73 Dulwich Village by 10m to accommodate more easily deliveries to the business.

FIRBANK ROAD (Nunhead & Queen's Road)

- it is recommended to install 15m of DYLs on Firbank Road to allow larger vehicles to turn into and out of the entrance to Saskia Mews.

GALLERY ROAD (Dulwich Village)

- it is recommended to introduce 35m of DYLs on the north-west side on either side of the controlled area of the existing zebra pedestrian crossing, and 27m of DYLs on the south-east side outside the Dulwich Preparatory School;
- to extend an existing length of DYLs north-east of the Dulwich Preparatory School north-eastward by a distance of 35m;
- to introduce 8.7m of DYLs across the vehicular access route to Chapel Cottage to prevent vehicles blocking the vehicle crossover and improve visibility.

<u>HOWLETTS ROAD</u> (Dulwich Village)

- it is recommended to replace 9m of existing single yellow line on Howletts Road with DYLs to maintain access to the parking bay on Warmington Road.

MILO ROAD (Dulwich Village)

- it is recommended to install 16m of DYLs on both sides on either side of the existing lockable fire gate to prevent vehicles obstructing the operation of the gate and the access of emergency services.

SYDENHAM HILL (Dulwich Wood)

- it is recommended to introduce, or to extend existing, junction protection measures at several locations along Sydenham Hill to prevent obstructions and improve visibility at junctions:- at its junctions with Woodsyre, Crouchmans Close, access route to Attleborough Court and Dunton Court, its access route to Beltwood House, No. 41 Sydenham Hill, and an extension of an existing DYL north of its junction with Rock Hill.

Disabled Persons' Parking Places:

- to provide new disabled persons' parking places, 6 metres in length, which would operate at any time and may be used without time limit by vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons 'blue badge', at the following locations: -


<u>BEAUVAL ROAD</u> (Dulwich Village) on the south-west side outside No. 18 Beauval Road; <u>DUNSTANS ROAD</u> (Old Kent Road) on the south-east side outside No. 127 Dunstans Road; <u>PELLATT ROAD</u> (Goose Green) the south side outside No. 27 Pellatt Road; and <u>THOMPSON ROAD</u> (Goose Green) on the north side outside No. 40 Thompson Road.

- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2013 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2013 thereto

- 3.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order is designated as a parking place.
- 3.2 The provisions of the Order of 2013 (other than Articles 3.1 and 14.1) shall apply to each area described in the Schedule to this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place shall include a reference to each area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2013 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2011 thereto

- 3.2 The provisions of the Order of 2011 (other than Articles 3.1 and 11.1) shall apply to the area described in the Schedule to this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place shall include a reference to the area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to the Schedule to the Order of 2011 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs etc.

 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order;

The council of the London Borough of Southwark, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 201* and shall come into force on xx xxxx 201*.

Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

- "the Order of 2015" means the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) Consolidation Order 2015^b, as amended.
- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2015 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.
