- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The effect of the orders would be:- note: 'permit parking places' refer to parking for holders' of valid parking permits within the CPZ listed; and 'shared-use' parking places' refer to parking in which holders' of a valid permit for the CPZ listed or paid ticket holders' are permitted to park within the permitted hours. All measurements are in metres 'm' and are approximate.
- (a) in AMELIA STREET, in CPZ 'E' near its junction with lliffe Yard, (i) the north-west side to reduce an existing permit parking place by 3m and (ii) the south-east side to reduce an existing 'pay' parking place by 7m;
- (b) in COMMERCIAL WAY, the north-west side to introduce a new ambulance stopping area (10 meters in length) in which, at any time, ambulances only are permitted to stop without restriction;
- (c) in KING AND QUEEN STREET, the north-east side, increase by 12m the length of an existing 'shared-use' parking place in CPZ 'M2';
- (d) in THRALE STREET, in CPZ 'C1' to relocate 22 metres of existing permit holders' parking place on the south-west side to the north-east side;
- (e) in WINGFIELD STREET, the north-west side to extend, by 2m north-eastward, an existing 'unlimited stay' disabled persons' parking place *outside* No. 7 Wingfield Street;
- (f) to convert existing permit holders' parking places, in part or in full, to 'limited stay' disabled persons' parking places, 6 metres each in length, which would operate at any time (max stay 4 hours) by vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons 'blue badge':- (i) in THURLAND ROAD, a full bay on the south-west side *opposite* St. James's Church in CPZ 'G', and (ii) in WILD'S RENTS, part of an existing bay on the south-east side *outside* No. 30 Wild's Rents in CPZ 'D';
- (g) to provide cycle hangars on the carriageway, each having 2.55 metres in length and 2.05 metres in width, and aligned parallel to the kerb, at the following locations:- in GELDART ROAD, the north-east side (i) to the side of No. 72 Meeting House Lane, and (ii) to the side of No. 34 Fenham Road; and in GOODRICH ROAD, the north-east side to the side of No. 239 Upland Road;
- (h) to convert existing single yellow line to double yellow 'at any time' waiting restrictions in:-CHESTERFIELD GROVE, the north side outside No. 1 Chesterfield Grove (12m), and RAYMOUTH ROAD, the north-east side outside Banner Court (12m); and ROTHERHITHE NEW ROAD, on both sides, at various points between its junction with the vehicular access to Beamish House and its junction with Luxford Street (approx. total of 138m);
- to add new 'at any time' waiting restrictions in:- BARKWORTH ROAD and DELAFORD ROAD at junctions with Credon Road; LUXFORD STREET at its junction with Rotherhithe New Road; HOLBECK ROW at its junction with Friary Road; and
- (j) to amend existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions in:- AMELIA STREET, (i) the north-west side add 3m and (ii) the south-east side add 8.5m; CREDON ROAD across its junctions with Barkworth Road, Delaford Road, Masters Drive and Ryder Drive; ELCOT AVENUE at its junction with Friary Road; FENHAM ROAD across its junctions with Friary Road and Marmont Road, and at its junction with Furley Road; FRIARY ROAD, across its junctions with Elcot Avenue, Fenham Road and Holbeck Row; FURLEY ROAD across its junction with Fenham Road; GOODRICH ROAD, north-east side south-west of cycle hangar add 2m; KING AND QUEEN STREET, the north-east side add 13.8m; MARMONT ROAD at its junction with Fenham Road; MASTERS DRIVE at its junction with Credon Road; PECKHAM PARK ROAD, the south-east side between Bird in Bush Road and Commercial Way add 35m; RYDER DRIVE at its junction with Credon Road; THRALE STREET, (i) the north-east side remove 22m and (ii) the south-west side add 22m; THURLAND ROAD the south-west side to more

- accurately reflect current restrictions in the road; and UNDERHILL ROAD, the east side add 4m between No. 8 and Bradbury Oak House, Underhill Road.

A minor traffic scheme (or non-strategic traffic and highway improvement) is a small project where the council proposes to modify the existing Highway layout. This may include changes to waiting and loading restrictions, parking places, improved crossing facilities etc. *Note: All measurements are approximated and 'DYLs' refer to double yellow lines ('at any time' waiting restrictions).* 

This batch of schemes proposes the following changes in the the London Borough of Southwark:-

AMELIA STREET (Newington) 'E' CPZ is in operation 8.30am - 6.30pm Monday - Friday

- reduce in length by 3m one existing permit holder's only parking place outside No. 230 Amelia Street;
- reduce in length by 8.5m one existing 'shared-use' parking place opposite No. 230 Amelia Street;
- install DYLs on both sides to maintain access to and from liffe Yard.

<u>COMMERCIAL WAY</u> (Peckham) - add new ambulance only stopping area 10m in length outside the Tayo Situ House - Nursing Home.

KING AND QUEEN STREET (North Walworth) 'M2' CPZ is in operation 8.30am – 6.30pm Monday – Friday - it is recommended to remove 25.8m School Keep Clear Marking as the school entrance has moved location and replace with 13.8m DYLs to be installed to allow vehicle passing place; and 12m additional shared use parking bays.

<u>THRALE STREET</u> (Borough & Bankside) 'C2' CPZ is in operation 8 am to 11 pm - relocate 22 metres of existing permit holders' parking place on the south-west side to the north-east side.

#### **DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES:**

**LIMITED STAY** to convert existing permit holders' parking places, in part or in full, to 'limited stay' disabled persons' parking places, 6 metres each in length, which would operate at any time (max stay 4 hours) by vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons 'blue badge', in:

THURLAND ROAD (North Bermondsey) a full bay on the south-west side opposite St. James's Church in CPZ 'G', and

<u>WILD'S RENTS</u> (Chaucer) part of an existing bay on the south-east side outside No. 30 Wild's Rents in CPZ 'D'

**UNLIMITED STAY** <u>WINGFIELD STREET</u> (Rye Lane) it is recommended to extend the 'unlimited stay' disabled persons' parking place *outside* No. 7 Wingfield Street by 2m north-eastward to improve visibility.

CYCLE HANGARS: cycle hangars have been requested in the below locations

<u>GELDART ROAD</u> (Peckham) the north-east side (i) to the side of No. 72 Meeting House Lane, and (ii) to the side of No. 34 Fenham Road; and

GOODRICH ROAD (Dulwich Hill) the north-east side to the side of No. 239 Upland Road.

**WAITING RESTRICTIONS:** AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING RESTRICTIONS and NEW LENGTHS of DOUBLE YELLOW LINES

<u>CHESTERFIELD GROVE</u> (Goose Green) it is recommended to replace 12m of existing single yellow line on the north side outside No. 1 Chesterfield Grove with DYLs.

<u>RAYMOUTH ROAD</u> (North Bermondsey) it is recommended to replace 12m of existing single yellow line on the north-east side outside Banner Court with DYLs.

#### ROTHERHITHE NEW ROAD (Rotherhithe, North Bermondsey and South Bermondsey)

- it is recommended to make any part, on both sides, of Rotherhithe New Road between its junction with the vehicular access to Beamish House and its junction with Luxford Street (approx. total of 138m) DYLs where there were previously no waiting restrictions or single yellow line waiting restrictions.

<u>BONAMY ESTATE</u> (Old Kent Road) - it is recommended to install double yellow lines as junction protection at Credon Road's junctions with Masters Drive, Ryder Drive, Delaford Road and Barkworth Road.

FRIARY ROAD AREA (Peckham) - it is recommended to to install double yellow lines on junctions of Furley Road and Fenham Road, Fenham Road and Marmont Road, and Friary Road's junctions with Holbeck Row and Elcot Avenue.

<u>PECKHAM PARK ROAD</u> (Old Kent Road) - it is recommended to add DYLs to make south-east side DYLs throughout between Bird in Bush Road and Commercial Way.


<u>UNDERHILL ROAD</u> (Dulwich Wood) - it is recommended to install 4m of DYLs to prevent obstructive parking and maintain visibility between No. 8 Underhill Road and Bradbury Oak House.

#### Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'M2') (No. \*) Order 201\* and shall come into force on xx xxxxx 201\*.

#### Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

"the Order of 2007" means The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'M2') (No. 1) Order 2007  $^{\rm b}$ .

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2007 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

#### Revocation

3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done, or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order the designation by the Order of 2007 of the parking place numbered 74 in Schedule 3 therein, is hereby revoked.

#### Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2012 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, and having a width throughout of 2 metres is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2007 (other than Articles 3 and 10) shall apply to each area designated as a parking place this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place shall include a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if reference to Schedule 3 to the Order of 2007 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

#### Placing of traffic signs, etc.

- 5.1 The council shall:-
  - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order;
  - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order traffic signs indicating that such parking places may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Articles 4.1 and 4.3 of the Order of 2007:
  - (c) carry out such other works as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

The council of the London Borough of Southwark, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

#### Citation and Commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Ambulance stopping areas) (No. \*) Traffic Order 201\* and shall come into force on xx xxxxxxxx 201\*.

#### Interpretation

2.1 In this Order -

"ambulance" has the same meaning as that given in item 6(2) of Schedule 2 to the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1984<sup>b</sup>;

"ambulance stopping area" means an area of highway described in the Schedule to this Order;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

"the Order of 2009" means the London Borough of Southwark (Ambulance Stopping Areas) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2009°.

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2009 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.
