Amendment to CPZ 'Q'

*The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (Parking zone 'Q') (No. *) Order 201**

1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above order under the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, as amended.
2. The effect of the order would be: - to provide a 'shared-use' parking place, in which either:-
(i) vehicles which have paid the parking charge of £2.75 per hour (using 'Pay by Phone') may be left for up to two hours (provided no vehicle may return to a parking place on that same day), or
(ii) vehicles issued with a valid residents' permit, valid business permit or valid visitors' permit may be left without time limit, between the hours of 11 am and 1 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, in:- GROVE PARK, the easternmost north-west to south-east arm, on the south-west side, at the side of No. 37 Grove Park (40 metres in length).

Statement of reasons

Amendment to CPZ 'Q'

*The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (Parking zone 'Q') (No. *) Order 201**

The proposal is to provide a new parking bay, 40 metres in length, in Grove Park (within the Champion Hill ward), London Borough of Southwark.

This proposal was originally a part of the implementation of Controlled Parking Zone known as CPZ 'Q', which covers the Dog Kennel Hill area. Due to an error in the Notice of Making for Dog Kennel Hill Controlled Parking Zone (published in *The London Gazette* on 13 December 2018, <https://www.thegazette.co.uk/notice/3170804>) which listed an additional 'shared-use' bay in 'Grove Hill Road' rather than 'Grove Park', this proposal must be re-advertised separately.

The proposed bay will be a 'shared-use' parking place, in which either: -

(i) vehicles which have paid the parking charge of £2.75 per hour (using 'Pay by Phone') may be left for up to two hours (provided no vehicle may return to a parking place on that same day), or
(ii) vehicles issued with a valid residents' permit, valid business permit or valid visitors' permit may be left without time limit, between the hours of 11 am and 1 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

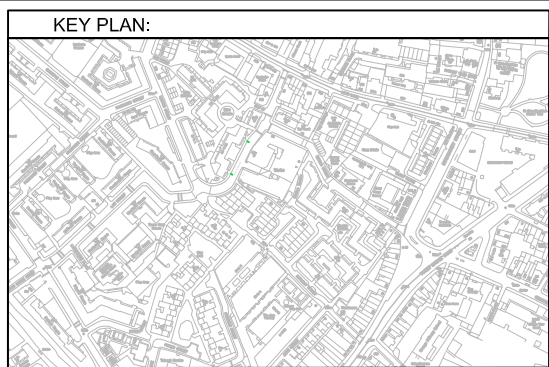
Located in GROVE PARK, the easternmost north-west to south-east arm, on the south-west side, at the side of No. 37 Grove Park (40 metres in length).

The council of the London Borough of Southwark, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

- 1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'Q') (No. 2) Order 2019 and shall come into force on xx xxxxxxxx 2019.

Interpretation

- 2.1 In this Order:

“council” means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

“enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

“the Order of 2018” means The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'Q') (No. 1) Order 2018^b.

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2018 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

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Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2018 thereto

- 3.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, and having a width of 2 metres throughout, is designated as a parking place.
- 3.2 The provisions of the Order of 2018 (other than Articles 3, 16 and 17) shall apply to each area designated as a parking place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place shall include a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 3 to the Order of 2018 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs, etc.

- 5.1 The council shall:-
- (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order;
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order traffic signs indicating that such parking places may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Articles 4.1 and 4.3, as the case may be, of the Order of 2018;
 - (c) carry out such other works as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order provides a new 'shared-use' parking place - for the use of both permit holders and 'pay by phone' users - in Grove Park, in the London Borough of Southwark.

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
