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Minor Traffic Scheme Southwark boundary roads

The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 201*

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above order under the power of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, as amended.
- 2. The effects of the order would be:-
- (a) to amend existing or add 'at any time' waiting restrictions in:-

GIBBON ROAD, the south-west side of its south-easternmost arm approx. 15 metres (opposite its junction with Hathway Street);

STOCKHOLM ROAD, both sides from its junction with Ilderton Road eastward for approx. 45 metres;

ZAMPA ROAD, both sides from its junction with Ilderton Road north-eastward for approx. 62.5 metres; and

- (b) to amend existing or add 'at any time' loading restrictions in the following roads to match the above changes:- GIBBON ROAD, STOCKHOLM ROAD and ZAMPA ROAD, in-line with the neighbouring London Borough of Lewisham – Minor Parking Projects 2019 amendments within the above-mentioned roads.

Statement of reasons

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A minor traffic scheme (or non-strategic traffic and highway improvement) is a small project where the council proposes to modify the existing Highway layout. This may include changes to waiting and loading restrictions, parking places, improved crossing facilities etc. *Note: All measurements are approximated and 'DYLs' refer to double yellow lines ('at any time' waiting restrictions).*

This batch of schemes propose the following changes in the London Borough of Southwark, inline with the neighbouring <u>London Borough of Lewisham</u> – Minor Parking Projects 2019 amendments within the following roads:-

(a) to amend existing or add 'at any time' waiting restrictions in:-

GIBBON ROAD – (Nunhead & Queen's Road ward) the south-west side of its south-easternmost arm approx. 15 metres (opposite its junction with Hathway Street);

STOCKHOLM ROAD – (Old Kent Road) on both sides from its junction with Ilderton Road eastward for approx. 45 metres; and


ZAMPA ROAD – (Old Kent Road) on both sides from its junction with llderton Road northeastward for approx. 62.5 metres; and

(b) to amend existing or add 'at any time' loading restrictions in the following roads to match the above changes:- GIBBON ROAD, STOCKHOLM ROAD and ZAMPA ROAD.





The council of the London Borough of Southwark, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 201* and shall come into force on xx xxxxxx 201*.

Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

"the Order of 2015" means the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) Consolidation Order 2015^b - as amended .

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2015 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Amendment of the Order of 2015

- 3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done, or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the Order of 2015 shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) for the item numbered 412, in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order;
 - (b) there were added to Schedule 1 to that Order the items numbered **** and **** and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order;
 - (c) for the item numbered 52, in Schedule 2 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 3 to this Order; and
 - (d) there were added to Schedule 2 to that Order the items numbered *** and *** and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 4 to this Order.
