## Pedal cycle quietways route Q14: Canada Water to South Dock

The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. \*) Order 201\*

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above order under the power of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, as amended.
- 2. The effects of the order, by way of amending existing or adding 'at any time' waiting restrictions (measurements of additional waiting restrictions are approximate and in metres 'm'), will be in:ARCHANGEL STREET, the south-east side opposite its junction with Timber Pond Road (20m);

FINLAND STREET, (i) the north-west side across its junction with Bonding Yard Walk (30m), and across its junction with the vehicular access to adjacent to Nos. 60 and 61 Finland Street (22m), and (ii) the south-east side across its junction with vehicular access to Helsinki Square (35m), and across its junction with South Sea Street (23m);

PRINCES COURT, all the part that is public highway from its junction with Rope Street (15m per side);

ROPE STREET, the north-west side across its junction with South Sea Street (22.5m); and

SOUTH SEA STREET, (i) the north-east side, from its junction with Finland Street to its junction with Rope Street (excluding the existing pedestrianised area), (ii) the south-west side, at its junction with Finland Street (6.5m), and (iii) both sides, at its junction with Rope Street (7.5m).

The amendments above are proposed to accommodate the extension of Quietway 14 from Canada Water to South Dock, which will re-surface and re-name the existing cycle tracks and lanes in the area.

## Statement of reasons

## Pedal cycle quietways route Q14: Canada Water to South Dock

The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. \*) Order 201\*

Pedal cycle quietways are a network of improved streets across London designed to make it easier for cyclists by calming traffic and ensuring streets are safer and improved for all road users. The measures include safer junctions, improved crossings for pedestrians, more efficient signal junctions and a more pleasant street environment.

This proposal aims to extend the route known as 'Quietway 14' – from Canada Water (Rotherhithe ward) to South Dock (Surrey Docks ward) in the London Borough of Southwark.

This is the easternmost section of this Quietway path and forms part of the wider Transport for London Quietways programme and in-line with the Southwark Cycling Strategy.

It connects to the western section of Quietway 14 between to Blackfriars Road and Tanner Street, and the eastern section of Quietway 14 between Jamaica Road and Canada Water.


The proposal will amend existing pedal cycle facilities and motor traffic restrictions to calm traffic and improve safe routes for cycles; and to reduce the volume of non-local through traffic, improving accessibility for pedal cycles in line with the agreed route alignment of Quietway 14.


#### The proposal will:


- Widen footways and improve surfacing throughout the area.
- Implement new and amend existing waiting restrictions throughout the area.



The council of the London Borough of Southwark, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. \*) Order 201\* and shall come into force on xx xxxxxxxx 201\*.

#### Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

- "the Order of 2015" means the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) Consolidation Order 2015<sup>b</sup> as amended by the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. 27) Order 2017<sup>c</sup>, the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. 48) Order 2018<sup>d</sup>, and the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. 52) Order 2018<sup>e</sup>.
- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2015 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.
