- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be, in:-
- (a) BRENCHLEY GARDENS, to add 15.5 metres of 'at any time' waiting restrictions on both sides at its junction with Brockley Way;
- (b) BROCKLEY WAY on the south-west side (between its junctions with Athenlay Road and Brenchley Gardens), to add 92 metres of 'at any time' waiting restrictions; and
- (c) SOUTHWARK PARK ROAD (between its junctions with Macks Road and St James's Road):-
- to remove an existing 11 metre 'short stay' parking place, on the south side (to the rear of No. 17 Abbey Gardens);
- (ii) to relocate an existing 11 metre loading bay from the north side (outside the boundary wall of Cherry Garden School) to the south side to replace the 'short stay' parking place mentioned above (operating 8:30am – 6:30 pm Mon to Fri, with a max. stay of 30 mins and no return within 2 hrs);
- (iii) to amend existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions on the north side to accommodate the above mentioned changes; and
- (iv) to introduce new loading restrictions on the north side, from its junction with Mack Road eastward for a distance of 47 metres (operating 7am 7pm Mon to Fri)

Minor Traffic Schemes – Southwark Park Road

The London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (No. *) Order 201* The London Borough of Southwark (Loading bays) (No. *) Order 201* The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 201*

As part of their Road Modernisation Plan, Transport for London (TfL) has identified several locations where improvements to the highway would reduce bus journey times.

Two such locations within the London Borough of Southwark are:-

- **Brockley Way** between its junctions with Athenlay Road and Brenchley Gardens in the Peckham Rye ward (on the boundary of the Borough of Lewisham ward: Telegraph Hill);
- Southwark Park Road between its junctions with Macks Road and St James's Road in the South Bermondsey ward

Brockley Way:

Southwark Council officers carried out site visits during the weekday peak period. It was observed that bus journeys are sometimes delayed through the narrow section of the road.

It is therefore proposed to introduce 'at any time' waiting restrictions, double yellow lines (DYLs), on the south side of the road, whilst the parking on the north side will remain unrestricted, this will provide enough space to allow vehicles to pass each other safely.

Also proposed in the area is the introduction of DYLs, as junction protection, in Brenchley Gardens at its junctions with Brockley Way.

Southwark Park Road:


Southwark Council officers carried out site visits during the weekday peak period at the eastbound bus stop, west of its junction with St James's Road. The surveys showed that buses accessing the bus stop are delayed when there are vehicles parked in the loading bay. It was also noted that vehicles are sometimes parked in the bay without loading or unloading.


Based on site survey and observation, it is recommended to relocate the existing loading bay on the north side of the road outside Cherry Gardens School to a location on the south side of the road, where there is currently an under-used 'short stay' inset parking bay. A loading ban will also be introduced 7am-7pm, Mon-Fri on Southwark Park Road between the junction with Macks Road and the eastbound bus stop 26204. This proposal will result in the loss of one 'short stay' parking bay.

Designation of loading bay and application of the Order of 2016 thereto

- 3.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, is designated as a loading bay.
- 3.2 The provisions of the Order of 2016 (other than Articles 3.1 and 12.1) shall apply to each area designated as a loading bay by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a loading bay shall include a reference to each area designated as a loading bay by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2016 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs etc.

- 4.1 The council shall:-
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each loading bay referred to in the Schedule to this Order;
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each loading bay referred to in the Schedule to this Order, traffic signs indicating that such a loading bay may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles referred to in Article 4.1 of the Order of 2016; and
 - (c) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a loading bay.
