# **Swan Street area improvements**



The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed route) (Swan Street) (No. \*) Traffic Order 201\* The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'D') (No. \*) Order 201\*

The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. \*) Order 201\*

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be, in:-
- (a) SWAN STREET (i) to extend an existing south-westbound 'one-way', working with cycle contraflow, to cover the full extent between its junctions with Trinity Street and Harper Road, (ii) on the north-west side within CPZ 'D', to replace three separate 'shared-use' parking places with two extended 'shared-use' parking places (total 77 metres in length) – an increase of approx. 12 metres of 'shared-use' parking, and (iii) on the north-west side, to add a new length of 'at any time' (double yellow lines) waiting restrictions of 11 metres opposite Flats 7 to 12 Gloucester Court, Swan Street;
- (b) TRINITY STREET the south-west side, to add 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) approx. 7.5 metres either side of its junction with Trio Place; and
- (c) TRIO PLACE, to convert all waiting restrictions to 'at any time' (double yellow lines).
- 3. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980<sup>2</sup> and in accordance with the provisions of the Highways (Traffic calming) Regulations 1999<sup>3</sup>, propose to construct speed tables of flat-top construction having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the entire width of the carriageway, at the following locations:- SWAN STREET from the south-western kerb-line of Trinity Street extending south-westward for a distance of 8 metres; and the entirety of TRIO PLACE from its junction with Trinity Street.

# Statement of reasons

## **Swan Street area improvements**

The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed route) (Swan Street) (No. \*) Traffic Order 201\* The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'D') (No. \*) Order 201\* The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. \*) Order 201\*

These implementations will make improvements to the part of Swan Street between its junctions with Trinity Street and with Harper Road; and Trio Place (off of Trinity Street) within the Chaucer ward, in the London Borough of Southwark.

The developer was granted planning permission (15/AP/3886) on 31st March 2016 which allows the development of 64 new residential units at the site at Nos. 25 - 29 Harper Road SE1 6AW.


#### Highway works include:-

- extending the existing south-westbound 'one-way' system, working with cycle contra-flow, to cover the entire section in Swan Street between its junctions with Trinity Street and Harper Road (this is already in place under a temporary Traffic Order);
- extending parking bays on the north-western side of Swan Street, within CPZ 'D', by replacing three separate 'shared-use' parking places with two extended 'shared-use' parking places (a total of approx. 77 metres of parking) an increase of approx. 12 metres of 'shared-use' parking;
- converting existing single yellow lines to double yellow lines ('at any time' waiting restrictions) throughout Trio Place;
- introducing a raised entry at Trio Place junction with Trinity Street and at Swan Street junction with Trinity Street;
- adding double yellow lines in Trinity Street across its junction with Trio Place, and between the proposed parking places in Swan Street (opposite Flats 7 to 12 Gloucester Court).

#### Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'D') (No. \*) Order 201\* and shall come into force on xx xxxxx 201\*.

#### Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

#### Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2010 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of a Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, and having a width throughout of 2 metres, is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2010 (other than Articles 3 and 15) shall apply to each area designated as a parking place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place shall include a reference to each area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 2 to the Order of 2010 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

#### Placing of traffic signs etc.

- 5.1 The council shall:-
  - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedules to this Order;
  - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in a Schedule to this Order traffic signs indicating that such a parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Articles 4.1 and 4.3 of the Order of 2010; and
  - (c) carry out such other works as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of the parking place.

"traffic sign" means a sign of any size, type and colour prescribed and authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

2.3 Any reference in this Order to a named street (or part thereof) means a street bearing that name which lies within the London Borough of Southwark.

#### Prescribed route

#### Swan Street

No person shall cause any vehicle, other than a pedal cycle using the contra-flow (north-eastbound) cycle lane, to proceed in that part of Swan Street which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Trinity Street and the north-eastern kerb-line of Harper Road.

#### Exemptions

- 4.1 Nothing in Article 3.1 preceding shall apply in relation to:-
  - (a) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
     or
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or
  - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; or
  - (d) any vehicle being used for the maintenance, improvement, re-construction, cleansing or lighting of that part of street; or
  - (e) any vehicle being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to that part of street of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or of any communications network (within the meaning of the Communications Act 2003<sup>e</sup>); or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign, if the vehicle cannot be used for that purpose in any other street or part of street.

#### Amendment of existing orders

5.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done, or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed Routes) (Various Streets) (No. 3) Traffic Order 2011<sup>f</sup> shall have effect as though the item in the Schedule to those Regulations numbered 12 were omitted.
